Player Code of Conduct

Players are referred to the Baldivis Soccer Club (BSC) Code of Conduct which all members are required to comply with.

Based on that Code all Players and Parents (on behalf of their child) accept that they will comply with the following behaviour in relation to all their dealings with BSC.

A player can only take part in an official game if they have registered and paid the full fees. Players may risk a fine and a ban for breaking this rule.

General

- Show respect and fair play to your opponents.
- Play within the laws and spirit of the game.
- Encourage, support and co-operate with your team-mates

Training

- Ensure you arrive at training at the agreed time with boots, shin pads and ready to work hard, listen and concentrate.
- If you're going to be late or are unavailable for training, ensure your coach is informed at the earliest opportunity.
- Foul language, verbal abuse or any violent conduct will not be tolerated and could lead to exclusion from BSC
- Never argue with your coach or his assistant and ensure that all training equipment is handled with proper care and attention.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your teams' performance will benefit and so will you.

Game Days

- Ensure you arrive at games at the agreed time (your coach will advise) with football boots, shin pads, appropriate socks and shorts. Ensure that you bring your team jersey if the coach has allowed you to take it home. Jewellery, watches, wristbands etc. must not be worn.
- If you're going to be late or are unavailable for games ensure your coach is informed at the earliest opportunity.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your teams' performance will benefit and so will you.
- Treat all team-mates as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another team-mate.
- Co-operate with your coach, team-mates and opponents. Without them there would be no game
- Respect the match officials (including volunteer match officials) and accept all decisions without question. You will not be able to affect a decision, so do not let it affect you.
- Verbal abuse of match officials, other players or spectators is not acceptable or permitted.
- Any sanctions that you receive, from a match official, for 'dissent by word or action', 'violent conduct', 'spitting at an opponent or any other person' or 'using offensive, 'insulting or abusive language and / or gestures' are unacceptable at BSC.
- Any sanction that involves a monetary penalty will be paid by the player not BSC.
- Shake hands with all team mates, opponents and match officials at the conclusion of the game.
